Ringette Association of Saskatchewan (RAS) High Performance Committee Terms of Reference (ToRs)

Mandate

The High Performance Committee ("the Committee") is responsible for providing developing, implementing, and managing the High Performance (HP) Ringette programs in Saskatchewan. These programs include, but are not limited to:

- Saskatchewan Heat (National Ringette League, NRL)
- Canada Winter Games (CWG)
- Saskatchewan Winter Games (SWG)

The Committee may also provide knowledge and assistance to Local Associations in the management and administration of AA and A programs.

Key Duties

The roles and responsibilities of the Committee include:

1. HP Program Development and Oversight

- Design, implement, and evaluate HP Ringette programs in Saskatchewan
- Ensure all programs align with the RAS Strategic Plan, Vision, and Goals
- Monitor participants' development and satisfaction throughout the programs

2. Athlete and Coach Identification and Development

- Identify and support potential and established HP athletes and coaches in Saskatchewan
- Develop pathways for HP athlete and coach progression in Saskatchewan
- Monitor athlete and coach development and satisfaction through regular assessments and evaluations

3. Coach Education and Support

- Provide training and professional development opportunities for potential and established HP coaches
- Ensure certification standards are met and align with competition requirements (NRL, CWG, SWG)

4. Official Education and Support

- Provide training and professional development opportunities for potential and established HP officials
- Ensure certification standards are met and align with competition requirements (NRL, CWG, SWG)

Authority

The Committee advises the RAS Board of Directors on High Performance Ringette programs in Saskatchewan.

Composition

The Committee will consist of:

- RAS Technical Director
- RAS Board Member
- Minimum one (1) representative from each Local Association
- Other members approved by the Board as needed

Committee Qualifications

Members should have:

- High Performance Ringette experience (as an athlete, coach, official, or administrator)
- Knowledge of High Performance competition standards/governance (NRL, CWG, SWG)
- Ability to think strategically to develop long-term plans and goals for the HP programs
- A passion for and commitment to the development of HP Ringette programs in Saskatchewan
- Ability to collaborate with Committee members, share ideas, and take action
- Ability to attend regular Committee meetings

Meetings

The Committee will meet as required (once per month) in person or electronically via Zoom.

Resources

The Committee will receive necessary resources from RAS to fulfill its mandate and may receive administrative support as needed.

Reporting

The Committee will report at every Board meeting and submit a written report at every Members meeting.

Approval and Review

The Board will regularly review these Terms of Reference, with input from the Committee as needed.
