

POST SECONDARY SCHOLARSHIPS

Ringette Saskatchewan awards four \$500 one-year scholarships to active Ringette Saskatchewan participants currently attending and enrolled (for current year), as a full-time student in a post-secondary institution in Saskatchewan.

The scholarships are awarded to assist in covering the cost of post-secondary education for ringette participants who have demonstrated a strong academic performance and a commitment to the sport of ringette.

Eligibility:

- The applicant must be a registered player, coach/manager/trainer or on-ice official active during the season of application.
- The applicant must be a Saskatchewan resident for a minimum of one year prior to application.
- The applicant must be enrolled in a Saskatchewan post-secondary institution as a full-time student.

Application:

- Application must be submitted to the Ringette Saskatchewan office by April 1st of the current playing year.
- The application must include a transcript of marks for the last completed year of education.
- The application must include two letters of reference, one of which must be from an individual within the ringette community.
- In addition to the letters of reference, applicants who serve as ringette board members or ringette school instructors must provide a letter from their local association President or ringette school operator detailing their involvement.
- The applicant must include an essay (maximum two pages), outlining:
 - The benefits of their ringette involvement
 - Extra-curricular activities
 - Community involvement
 - Number of years involved in ringette, in what capacity they were involved and in which community/communities.

Criteria:

- The applicant must complete, sign and submit the scholarship application by the April 1st deadline.
- The applicant must provide evidence of their full-time enrollment or application for full-time enrollment in an educational institution in Saskatchewan that is a university, college or other educational institution providing courses at a post-secondary level.
- During the season of application, the applicant must be registered and active as listed above

Successful applicants are not eligible to re-apply.

Selection:

- An appointed Ringette Saskatchewan selection committee will review all applications. Selection will be based on demonstrated ringette involvement and academic achievement. The selection committee reserves the right to decline a scholarship if a suitable application is not received. Decisions of the selection committee are final.
- All applicants will be notified by email by May 15th. Recipients will be required to submit a photo
 prior to receiving funds. Scholarship winners will be announced prior to the Ringette Saskatchewan
 Annual General Meeting, will be featured in the Ringette Saskatchewan Annual Report and on the
 Ringette Saskatchewan website.
